## What genres of music do your DJs play?

Our DJs are comfortable playing all genres of music. Versatility is key to a great wedding, and our DJs are skilled at curating playlists that suit a wide range of musical tastes.

## Which artists inspire the DJ approach at Venue 5126?

Our DJs are inspired by true entertainers—performers who bring energy and connection to the room. Influences include artists like Bruno Mars, George Michael, Justin Timberlake, Luther Vandross, and Calvin Harris.

## How would you describe the DJ style at Venue 5126?

The DJ style at Venue 5126 is energetic, flexible, and responsive. Our DJs follow the energy of the room and adapt their sets based on how guests are engaging with the music. No two crowds are the same, so each night is approached with a fresh perspective.

## What is the music selection process like?

Music sets are carefully crafted using a combination of the couple's request list, real-time crowd feedback, and the DJ's professional experience. The goal is always to create a unique soundtrack tailored to each wedding.

## How are technical issues handled during a set?

Our DJs are trained to stay calm and troubleshoot issues quickly, using a mental checklist to isolate and resolve problems. Backup equipment is available on-site in the event of equipment failure.

## How do DJs read the crowd and adjust music accordingly?

Throughout the night, DJs observe the dance floor and overall vibe of the crowd. Music is adjusted in real time to match the mood and keep the energy flowing.

## What strategies are used for less responsive crowds?

If a crowd is more reserved or less inclined to dance, DJs rely on the couple's must-play list and proven crowd-pleasers to spark engagement. DJs may also communicate with the couple during the event to determine how they'd like to proceed—whether to keep encouraging dancing or shift the mood.

## How are song requests managed?

Song requests are handled based on the couple's preferences. If allowed, DJs will take requests and fit them into the set when appropriate. If a request doesn't suit the current vibe, it may be saved for later in the evening.

## How do DJs communicate with clients before the wedding?

DJs are available via email and offer appointments for couples to discuss their vision and preferences. A final planning meeting is held during the week of the wedding to confirm all details.

## What happens if someone requests a song that's inappropriate?

If a request is deemed inappropriate for the event, the DJ will respectfully decline to play it, keeping the focus on the couple's vision and guest experience.
